December 12, 2018 - Holiday Happy Hour

The FBISTLCAAAA held its annual Holiday Happy Hour for FBI Citizens Academy graduates. Special Agent in Charge Richard Quinn spoke about the accomplishments of the St. Louis Division and the challenges it faces, his appreciation for the FBISTLCAAAA, and ideas on how the association can partner with the FBI to help improve the community. FBISTLCAAAA President Gary Chan also shared the organization's accomplishments in 2018 and painted a picture for what 2019 could be.

Thanks to generous donations from our members, we were able to serve almost 500 slices of free pizza to students and their families. The FBI passed out activity books to kids and information about the FBI Child ID App to parents. The school held the block party to build on the positive momentum gained after the FBI Safe Streets Gang Task Force dismantled a drug-trafficking ring which operated in the Clinton-Peabody housing complex.

October 21, 2018 - Fall Range Day

Members shot skeet and trap outside as well as pistol indoors. Proceeds were donated to the LDA Memorial Golf Tournament.

September 26, 2018 - FBI HQ and Academy Tour

FBISTLCA graduates visited FBI HQ in DC and FBI Academy in Quantico.

September 7, 2018 - 37th Annual LDA Memorial Golf Tournament

FBISTLCAAAA co-sponsored and participated in the law enforcement memorial golf event. The FBISTLCAAAA is responsible for \$1,100 in registration and the following donations: \$3,000+ in cash, raffle prizes (2 handguns and a PGA golf ball) and items for a silent auction (2 gun club gift certificates, a golf outing certificate, and 6 Cardinals box seats with parking passes).

September 7, 2018 - FBINCAAAA Leadership conference.

August 14, 2018 - FBISTLCAAAA Board Meeting and Annual Membership Meeting

July 17, 2018 - Anti-theft Device Donation

The FBISTLCAAAA donated \$1,000 towards the purchase of anti-theft devices for cars. The donation paid for devices for roughly four blocks of houses in south city as St. Louis Metropolitan Police went door-to-door throughout the year to meet with residents. The goal was to help prevent vehicles from getting stolen and used to commit violent crimes.

June 23, 2018 - St. Louis Cardinals Redbird Rookies Health Fair

The FBISTLCAAAA and FBI participated in a health fair for kids by passing out giveaways to children and teaching parents about the FBI Child ID App.

June 19, 2018 - Firearms Safety

The FBISTLCAAAA held a firearms safety event for members. Chief Kevin Scott of Ballwin, MO, gave an insightful keynote speech on how he would reinvent law enforcement in today's age to better serve the community. Afterwards, members were invited to use the simulation shooter or live fire range.

June 9, 2018 - Violence Prevention Commission Outreach Event

The mission was to go door-to-door in the Walnut Park neighborhood in North St. Louis to (1) hear directly from families about the specific resources and basic supports they need and (2) connect families to resources immediately or through ongoing follow-up and community events.

May 30, 2018 - FBISTLCAAAA Board Meeting and Orlando Pulse Nightclub Presentation

The FBI gave FBISTLCAAAA members a behind-the-scenes look at the Orlando Pulse Nightclub shooting investigation. Participants learned how the situation unfolded, the suspect's behavior before and during the shooting, and the challenges law enforcement encountered throughout the investigation.

May 23, 2018 - FBISTLCA Graduation Event

May 2, 2018 - Northwest Academy of Law

The FBI taught a 7-session course on Introduction to Law Enforcement to 10th graders at the Northwest Academy of Law High School in St. Louis. The course used a mock bank robbery to help students understand the investigation process from start to finish. FBISTLCAAAA volunteers helped by role playing during the mock robbery and awarded tablets to top students in the program.

April 28, 2018 - Classic Car Event

The St. Louis Metropolitan Police and St. Louis County Police took 30-40 middle schoolers to view classic cars where the FBISTLCAAAA had the opportunity to attend and engage with students while enjoying the car show.
